- ***The key challenge is to manage the transition***

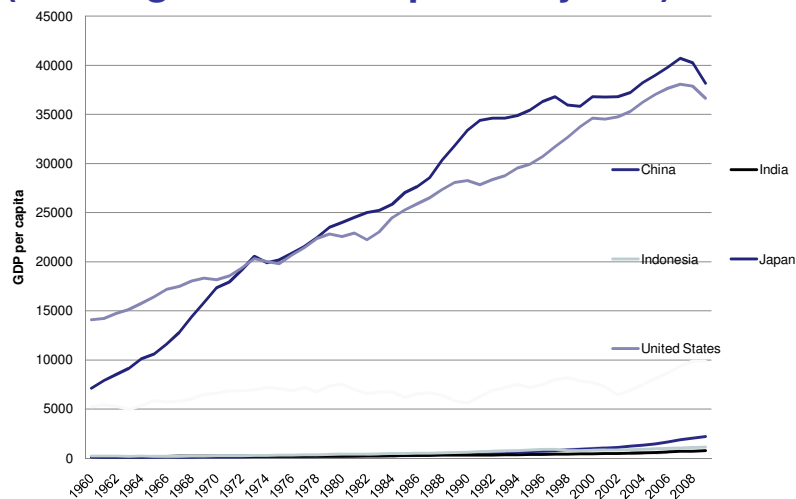
